

PREVENTING WORKERS' COMPENSATION FRAUD AT YOUR WORKPLACE



Watch out for these red flags of fraud:

- Employee's description of the accident appears questionable.
- Late reporting on the part of the employee or insured.
- Employee is unable to provide exact date, time and place of injury.
- The nature of the injury is not consistent with the type of work performed by the employee.
- Employee is not cooperating with the claim.
- Alleged accident or injury occurs on a Friday or Monday.
- Employee has an extensive claim history.
- A 'tip' is received that the employee is involved in activity that is inconsistent with the injury or has suffered a non-work related injury.
- Employee aggressively pursues legal action.
- No witnesses to the accident and or alleged injury.
